As you will be aware the opening of the Wales and the Battle of Britain 80th Exhibition by CAS will take place this Thu 16 Sep 21 at Cardiff City Hall. From Oct the exhibition will be available to tour Wales and I have been appointed by AO Wales to coordinate the tour. The aim of my email is to firstly introduce myself and secondly gather information to enable the exhibition to take place as the movement and manning of the exhibition will be done on a volunteer basis.

The Wales and the Battle of Britain 80th Exhibition, for those of you that cannot make the event on Thu to see it, consists of 14 display boards measuring 2.4m x 2.4m and was created by Dr Lynsey Shaw from the RAF's Air Historical Branch. The Wales and the Battle of Britain 80th Exhibition will be available for a period of up to a week from Oct 21 until Oct 22 and will hopefully generate some positive publicity for the RAF in Wales. For anyone who would like to host the exhibition AOW has asked that they:

- . Organise a small opening event to launch the arrival of the Exhibition in your location, AOW and myself will support each opening event if required.
- . Arrange some advanced publicity of the Exhibition to encourage and maximise attendance, including how the public can access it.
- . Ensure that the venue to be used is accessible free of charge.
