Thank you for your enquiry. For a representation to be relevant, it must relate to the likely effect of the grant of the licence in question, on the licensing objectives and be tailored to that premises.

There are other nearby stores with authorisation to sell alcohol off the premises only:

- Spar Quarella Road – 0800 to 2300 6 days a week
- Home Bargains – Market St – 0700 to 2200 hours 7 days a week
- Tesco – 0600 to 2300 hours 6 days a week
- Asda – 0600 to 2400 hours
- Aldi – 0600 to 0000 hours
- Iceland – 0800 to 2300 hours 6 days a week

Outside of Bridgend I have found the following timings for off sales only in convenience store/newsagent type premises.

- 0800 to 2300
- 0600 to 2200
- 0700 to 2000
- 0600 to 2300

Aside from the large supermarkets, I could not find a licence starting earlier than 0600 or operating beyond 2300 hours, but I would stress that only not all licences have been viewed and there are a variety of business models, from small convenience store to major retail chain, with the appropriate conditions attached all of which fall under the category of off sales.

The representation must relate to one of the following and not the issue of setting a precedent:

- Prevention of crime and disorder
- Public Nuisance
- Public Safety
- Protection of children from harm.
